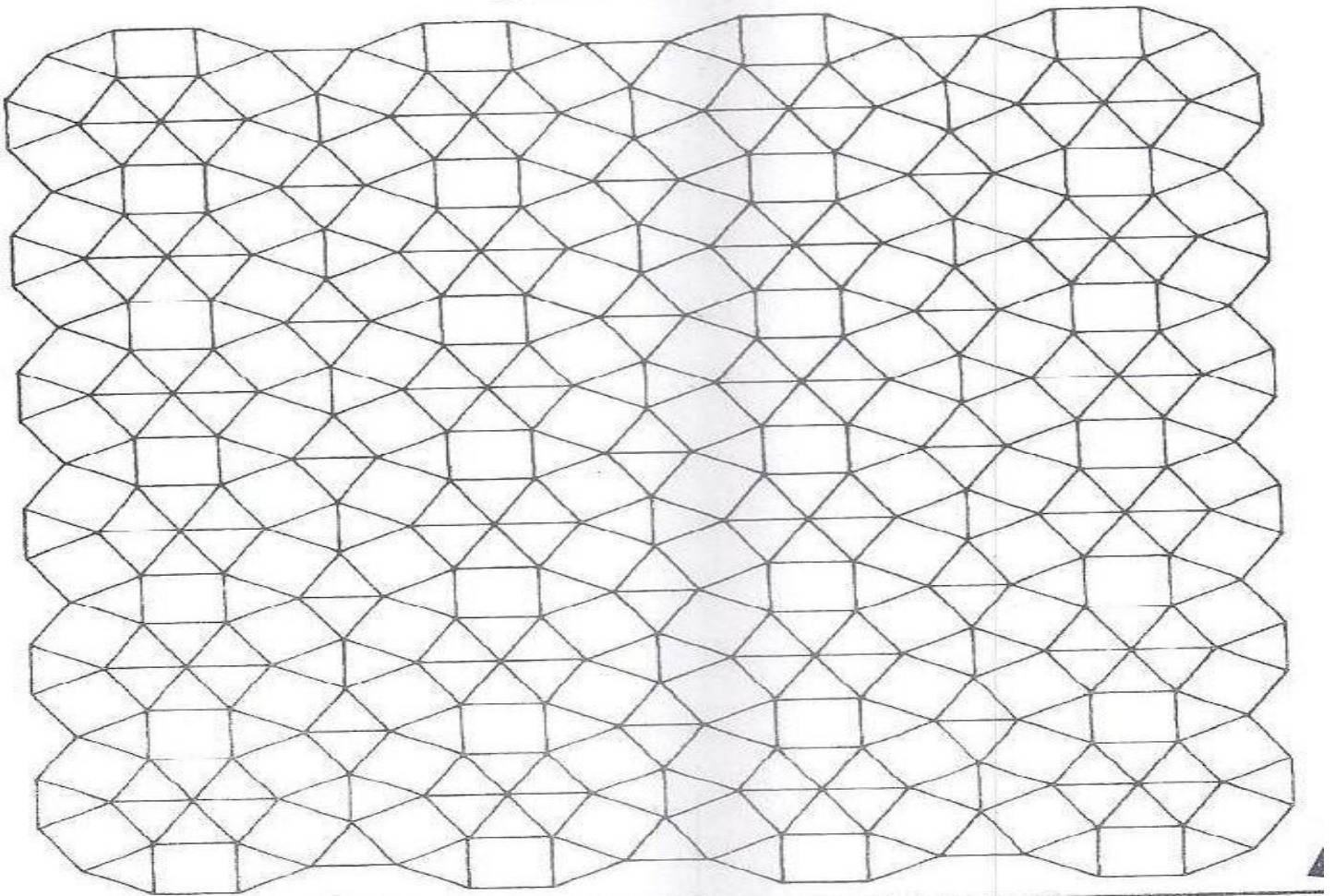

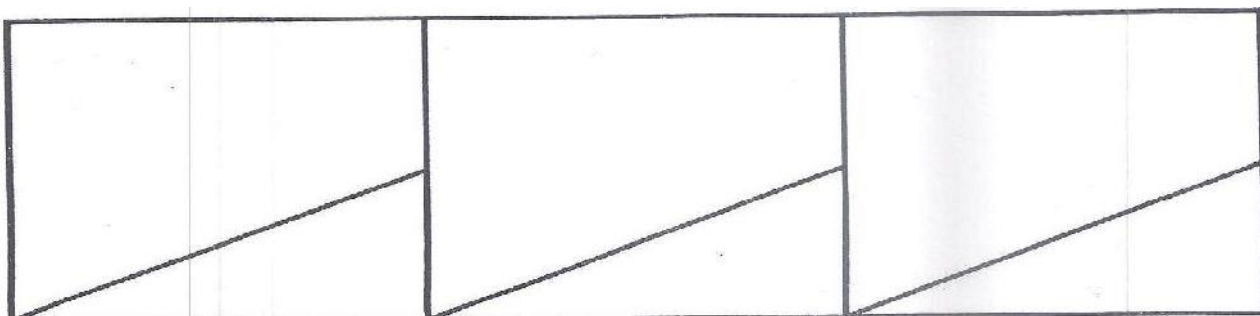
## MATHEMATICS

4. Colour or shade this design to highlight the different shapes or patterns. Use different colours.

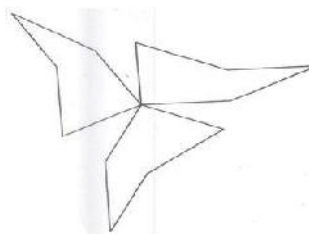


### 5. **CHIP OFF THE OLD BLOCK**

Step 1:

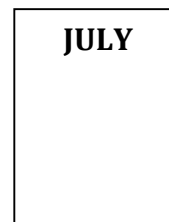
- Take an A3 sheet
