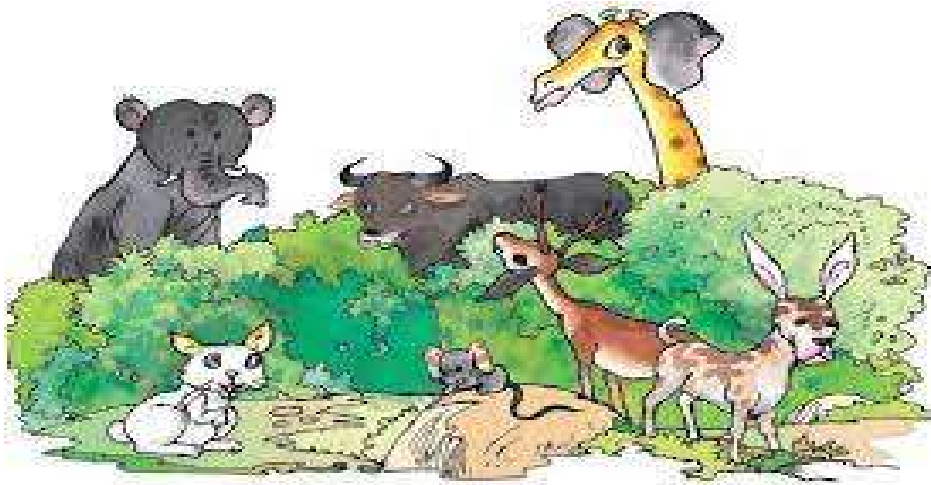

Who is the shortest?

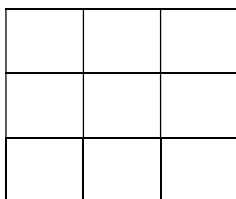
Who is the heaviest?
