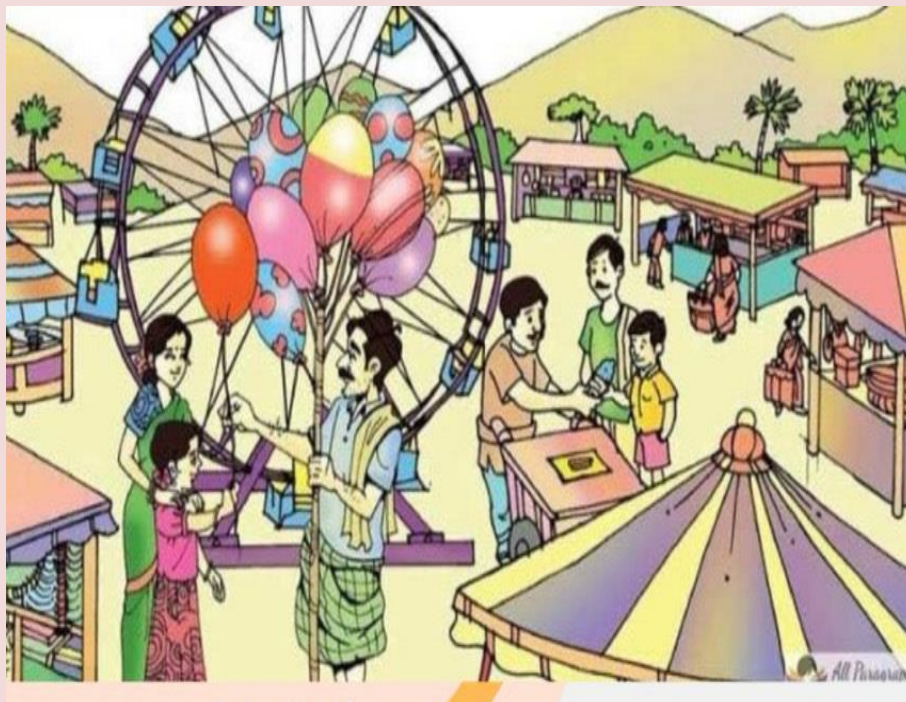
Q1. Vacation Journal and Itinerary

Also find out about any folk song based on the flowers sung in your family during wedding/festival or any particular occasion. Learn and write the song on coloured A4 sheets.

Q4.

Nature Walk

Go for a nature walk with your parents. Observe natural vegetation around. Find out common trees in your area. Collect and record the following information about any five plants on coloured A4 sheets.

- Does the flower grow on the tree?
- In which month does its leaves fall out?
- Do fruits grow on the tree?
- When do the flowers of that tree bloom?
- What are the physical characteristics of the plant such as its height, stem, texture, leaf shape, and color?
- How does the tree contribute to its surrounding ecosystem, such as providing shade, oxygen, medicine or habitat for other organisms?

Nutty Insects

Collect some shells of walnut/pistachio/peanuts. Make some insects using shells, color them and paste in your scrap book. Find out about any one insect in detail.



Q6.

Plantation Drive

On the occasion of World Environment Day, plant at least five saplings of trees with your family at your home or in neighborhood. Daily take care of them. Click pictures, make a collage in your scrapbook.

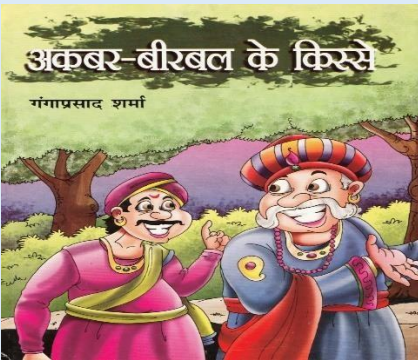

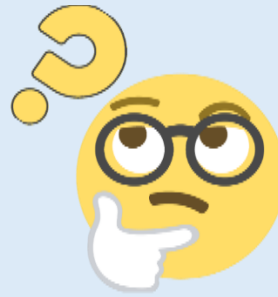

प्रश्न 6) सुलेख पुस्तक में दस पृष्ठ सुलेख लिखिए।



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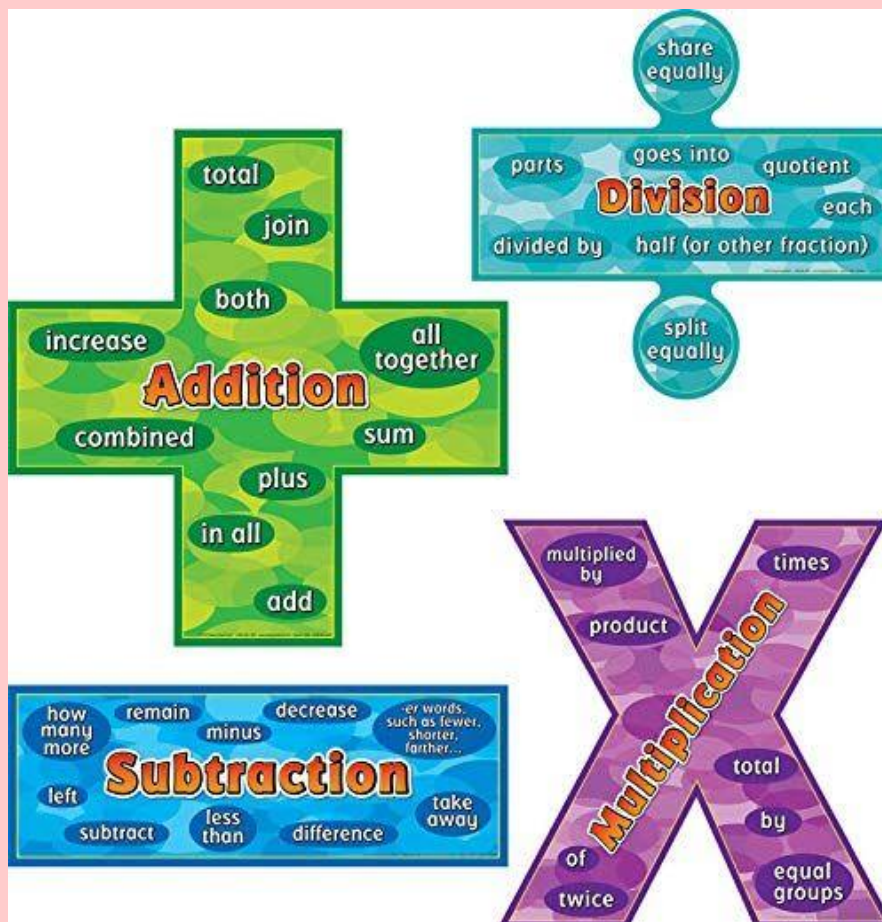
General Instruction: Do Q No 2,3,5 and 6 on coloured A4 sheet.

Q3. Solve the given riddle.

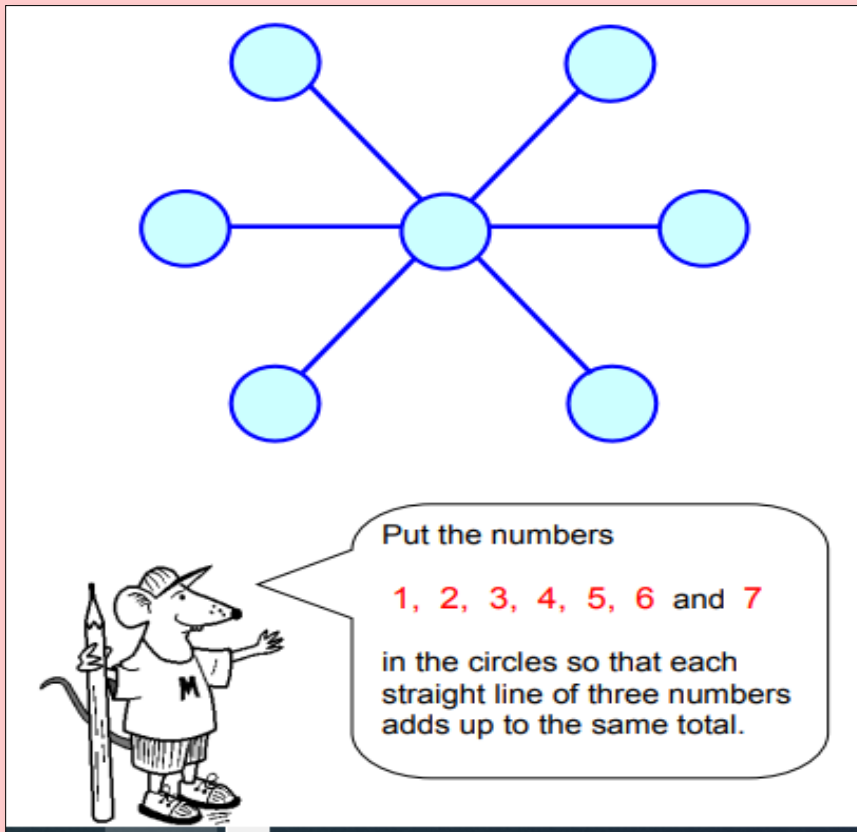
